### **Tuckton Roundabout Highway Improvement Works**

Bournemouth Council will be carrying out works to improve Tuckton roundabout, commencing 5<sup>th</sup> March 2018. The main objectives of the scheme are to reduce accidents on the roundabout, improve accessibility for pedestrians, improve cycle facilities and reduce congestion outside Tesco Express on Tuckton Road.

The works will be carried out on behalf of the Council by Dyer & Butler. The project is expected to be completed by the end of October 2018, which includes a break for the summer period. The improvement works will include the following:

- Construction of four new raised zebra/parallel crossings on each arm of the roundabout.
- Resurfacing and widening the footways around the roundabout to enable them to be shared with cyclists and to link with the Stour Valley Way cycle route.
- Widening the carriageway outside Tesco Express to resolve the congestion issue.
- The installation of lane designation markings on all four approaches to the roundabout and on the roundabout.
- Installing “no right turn signs” and prohibiting traffic from turning right into and out of the Harvester Public House on Tuckton Bridge.

Temporary traffic signals will be in use at times during construction and road closures are planned for the following times:

- Wick Lane (between Brightlands Avenue and Tuckton Roundabout) - for 4 weeks from 05<sup>th</sup> March 2018.
- Belle Vue/Stour Road/Tuckton Bridge (between Tuckton Roundabout and Willow Way) - for 2 weeks from 30<sup>th</sup> March 2018.
- Belle Vue Road (South) - for 6 weeks from 14<sup>th</sup> May 2018.
- Tuckton Road - for 4 weeks from 18<sup>th</sup> June 2018.

Alternative routes will be signed and advance notice communicated regarding any changes to the proposed road closures.

Information about changes to bus services/routes will be provided by Transdev Yellow Buses. Please contact them for information.

We apologise in advance for any inconvenience these works will cause and would like to assure you that every effort will be made to keep disruption to a minimum.
