Parents should note that the following change to the Admission Policy 2018-19 are proposed:

The definition of Parent(s)/Carer(s) within the Primary Admissions Policy 2019-20 and Secondary Admissions Policy 2019-20 has been changed to include the following:-

Parent(s)/Carer(s)

A Parent/Carer is any person who has parental responsibility for or is the legal guardian of the child as set out in the Children Act 1989. Where responsibility for a child is 'shared', only one application can be considered. Where Parents are separated it is essential that agreement is reached by both parties concerning the application. If agreement cannot be reached in the case of parents with joint Parental Responsibility, the Academy will only consider the application from the Parent who subsequently provides proof of their sole authority to decide upon matters of education and whose address will be used for admissions purposes.

In addition to the publication on the School website, the policy is also being sent directly to all local Parishes for publication to parishioners and is being made available to all parents and any visitor to the School who may wish to inspect a hard copy of the document.

All parents will be notified of the proposed changes and directed to look at this page on the website for details of where to direct comments.

The Governing Body will consider any comments received either directly or via the Local Authority before determining the final Admission Policy 2019-20 which will be duly published on the School website.
