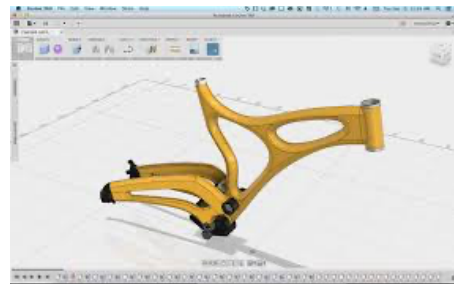


# Summer Task – Product Design.

We use a package called Fusion 360 a lot in A level Product Design. It is superb 3D modelling software that allows us to realise our ideas and begin to model and test them. It can also link directly with the 3D printers. To use this you will need to sign up with Autodesk and create an account for personal use. This allows you to edit up to 10 files at any time which is more than enough for A level and keeps it completely free! The link is below to do this.
