Complete all homework, meet coursework deadlines and catch up on work missed through absence. Keep an up to date record of work in the Diary.	Sign the Diary weekly and reply to school correspondence.	Monitor pupil progress (sign the Diary weekly); send home Effort & Attainment grades for all subjects towards the end of Autumn and Spring terms. In addition you will be sent a full Annual Report.
